The Women's Forum held on 21 June 2014 was jointly organized by St. Anthony's Catholic Parish, Toowoomba Spiritualist Church, Islamic Interfaith and Multicultural Committee of Toowoomba, and Pure Land Learning College Association. It attracted ninety-five participants, representing many diverse groups from the community. This included young women from the Afghan community, and representatives from the faiths, schools, and the community.

Yarn time was very enjoyable and engaging, with many women and young ladies sharing their stories. Many said that the women's forum should be a regular feature and suggested the focus should be on morality, education and family development.

It is interesting to note that for some of the young women from Afghanistan said that this was their first social interaction with the local diverse community since coming to Toowoomba. They were very much at ease in participating as their voices were heard during Yarn Time.
